In-House Student Transfers

- 1. An enrolled child may continue to participate in the Head Start program until they are eligible for public school.
- 2. Children, who transfer from classroom to classroom, or center to center, will be transferred with the least amount of interruption possible.
- Classrooms designated as a 4 year old classroom will accept in-house transfers as long as that transfer will not cause the size to exceed 20 children.
- 4. Classrooms designated as a 3 year old classroom will accept in-house transfers as long as that transfer will not cause the size to exceed 17 children.
- 5. The center with the vacancy will complete recruitment and enrollment within the 30 days as per classroom enrollment Policy 1-13.
- 6. At no time will a classroom's enrollment exceed the limits outlined in Performance Standard 1306.32.
- 7. The receiving center will meet with the family to update enrollment forms as needed (at the minimum, Form 3-11 and the USDA Enrollment Form will be updated). A copy of the updated USDA Enrollment Form will be sent to the administration office.
- 8. The transferring center will complete CP3 and immediately complete documentation for TS Gold. The child's file will be delivered to the receiving center.
